Old Town Nativity Play *"The Journey"*

is a major ecumenical Christmas community project which will tell the story of the birth of Jesus in a colourful, interactive and imaginative way

It will be a transient piece of theatre, taking the audience through the journey as imagined for Joseph and Mary. The colours and feel of the piece will be heavy and rich, using lights and texture to create the sense of a journey taken by many as they head to the census. As we move along, the audience will encounter small vignettes of street theatre to give them a sense of the bigger picture as to how the population felt at this time of great uncertainty and upheaval. We will see conflict and disagreement to reflect the true nature of this gruelling truth as they move towards the final destination. It is intended that this draw parallels with those within our own community today who find themselves, refugees, We anticipate audience numbers being upwards of 2000 per performance, based on the experience of the 2016 Passion Play performed in Wroughton which also

had the same director, Anna Friend.
