At the beginning of a new year, it's amazing that, in 2024, we're now approaching the halfway point in this decade! Soon, we shall find that we're a quarter of the way through this 21st century. It seems hard to believe if, like me, you still clearly remember the turn of the new Millenium and all that went with it.

Perhaps, if you're like me, you get very reflective at the start of a new year. It's around now, that I become conscious, once again, that time - and life in general - seems to be flying past. I want to make the most of the remaining time; I want to make the most of every second of every minute; I want to make the most of every conversation; I want to make the most of every opportunity.
